Understanding NHD geomancy, a Realtor[®]

NGO HUNG DIEN GEOMANCY

- Ngo Hung Dien geomancy (NHD) is a natural science.
- It is applied to benefit from the “khi” or vital energy of the universe and from the best arrangements of objects and structures to encourage the flow of “khi”, based on the laws of harmony and the laws of functionality.
- These two laws are used to create a harmonious and functional living environment for the wellbeing of all subjects affected by these surroundings.



WHAT IS “KHI”?

- “Khi” is the vital energy of the universe.
- The presence of “khi” in an area can be seen from:
 - * The cleanliness and freshness of the air,
 - * The greenness of the leaves of the trees and bushes,
 - * The solidity and the beautiful shapes of the trunks and branches of the trees,
 - * Types of colors of the paint, bricks or stones on the walls of a structure over time...
 - * The shade of the trees or of the structure

HOW DOES NGO HUNG DIEN GEOMANCY WORK?

- **NHD geomancy provides guidance on ways to observe and direct the “khi” of an area so that it flows to a property and makes the property more favorable for subjects living on the property.**
- **Create a logical arrangement of objects in the area and/or the property that makes the objects on the property fully functional.**

HOW TO APPLY NGO HUNG DIEN GEOMANCY

1. Identify/define all of the essential features of the property, including:

- * The access roads to the area and or property,
- * The size and layout of the front or back yards;
- * The presence and location of big trees or bushes;
- * The buildings or other structures etc...

2. Evaluate the property against corresponding sets of NHD geomancy principles.

3. NHD geomancy is composed of a list of essential geomancy features, their descriptions, good/bad aspects, and fixable or not fixable.

HOW TO APPLY NGO HUNG DIEN GEOMANCY (Cont.)

4. Ngo Hung Dien's geomancy goes hand in hand with his principles of physiognomy.
5. NHD geomancy can be used effectively in combination with physiognomy to ensure that a property, or the location of objects on the property, are suitable for, and as harmonious as possible with, the physiognomy of the person or persons (a family) under consideration.

HOW TO APPLY NGO HUNG DIEN GEOMANCY (Cont.)



6. The understanding of physiognomy improves the guidance from the geomancy.

PHYSIOGNOMY IN GEOMANCY

- Battlefront Forehead: A person who has a battlefront forehead should live in a house off the main street and in an area with many alleys.
- Person with a Mouse-Like Physiognomy should live in a house far off the main street that has more depth than width in its shape.
- A squat, heavy person should live at a location in an area that is lower down, or on a lower floor of a building. This rule applies both to this person's residence and to his/her business or office.

PHYSIOGNOMY IN GEOMANCY

- A person who is tall or looks tall, solid and well-built, or who has a healthy bird physiognomy should live in a house at a higher location in a given area or on a higher floor of a building.
- Good House for a Person with Yin Skin: A person with a Real Estate zone that has more yin substance should avoid living in a low-lying area, in an area that lacks sunlight, or near a cemetery.
- A good house must be surrounded by the trees with spirit. A tree with spirit is a tree which looks strong, healthy, and lively, and its trunks, branches and leaves have a good shape.

PHYSIOGNOMY IN GEOMANCY

- A person with thick skin, solid built body, slow and sluggish should live in a house at T-junction.
- People with sick bird physiognomy should not live in mountainous areas.
- A person with a forehead whose skin looks dark and as strong as steel can live in a house facing North.

PHYSIOGNOMY IN GEOMANCY

- A person with angular face can live in the Western part of the country.
- A person with ying skin should not live in a house lack of sunlight.

GEOMANCY TIPS

- Keep the foyer of your house clean, clear, and lighten up.
- Avoid painting your bedrooms with a gloomy, dark grey color.
- Avoid hanging pictures of animals in your bedrooms.
- Avoid hanging portrait photos of family member in your hall way.
- Avoid buying a house whose main floor has different floor level.

GEOMANCY TIPS

- Should wait at least one year if you want to cut down any trees in your yards after moving in a new house.
- Remove all dead branches, and dead bushes from your yards.
- Avoid buying a house whose windows facing a non-fixable sad, boring, or an ugly scenery.
- Avoid buying a house facing West or East whose front door and glass back door/window are facing each other.
- Avoid buying a house whose back yard falls down or steep sharply.
